Sky Walk — Private Dining at Fateh Garh

Rs. 7,500 per person · + 18% GST

Suspended above the Aravalli landscape on an open-air platform, the Sky Walk at Fateh Garh offers one of Udaipur's most singular dining settings. The countryside stretches beyond in every direction — the fields of Bujara Village below, the ancient hills above. An ideal setting for a candlelit dinner or an unhurried sundowner, arrived at in a vintage automobile from Fateh Niwas, with house wine and a setting of flowers and candlelight awaiting on arrival.

Suraj Gokhda — Private Dining at Fateh Garh

Rs. 4,500 per person · + 18% GST

Set within the uppermost reaches of Fateh Garh, the Suraj Gokhda is a private dining venue of rare distinction. Traditional arched architecture frames an unbroken panorama of Udaipur below and the open countryside beyond — a view that shifts with the light and deepens as evening descends. Reserved exclusively for private dining, it is an ideal setting for occasions that merit their own space.

Raaj Bagh — Private Dining at Fateh Sagar

A private dining arrangement on the banks of Fateh Sagar Lake, within the garden grounds of Raaj Bagh. The water stretches out before the table, the Aravalli hills rise on the far shore, and the city recedes quietly into the background. A setting of uncommon stillness for occasions that deserve it.

Chef's Special — The No-Menu Experience

An exercise in trust. There is no menu, no prior indication of what will be served — only the assurance that each course has been considered with care, crafted from fresh, seasonal, and locally sourced ingredients, and composed to tell a story particular to this kitchen and this moment. The Chef's Special dismantles the distance between table and kitchen, replacing it with conversation, surprise, and a meal that cannot be replicated.

Guests are invited to share dietary preferences and allergies in advance. Beyond that, the experience belongs entirely to the chef.

Vintage Car Hi-Tea & Sundowner

The route winds through countryside lanes to a village on the city's edge, where guests are invited to step out and observe the cadence of rural life at their own pace. The drive concludes at a carefully chosen vantage point where hi-tea and sundowner refreshments are laid out against an uninterrupted view of the Aravalli hills.

Marwari Horse Showcase & Hi-Tea

An intimate encounter with one of India's most storied equine breeds. The Marwari horse — distinguished by its characteristic inward-curving ears and bred for centuries by the Rathore clan of Marwar — holds a singular place in the history of Rajputana. This experience offers guests a guided breed presentation exploring the Marwari's lineage, physical distinction, and its enduring place within the cultural identity of the region. Hi-tea follows in the grounds of Fateh Vilas.

Jeep Safari — Village Walk & Sikligar Artisan Visit

A journey into the living heritage of Mewar. Departing in a vintage jeep from the Fateh Garh collection, guests are taken through countryside lanes into a neighbouring village — largely unchanged by time, where the rhythms of daily life unfold with quiet dignity. The excursion continues to the workshop of a Sikligar artisan.

The Sikligars are a hereditary community whose lineage is bound to the martial history of Rajputana. For generations, they have forged and maintained the swords, daggers, and weapons of warriors and royalty — their craft a living expression of precision, discipline, and ancestral pride. Guests witness the age-old techniques of iron and steel working firsthand, in the presence of craftsmen who carry this knowledge as an unbroken inheritance.

Jeep Safari with Farm Visit

The journey includes a visit to a working farm, where guests are welcomed to engage with the land — understanding the cultivation practices, seasonal rhythms, and agricultural traditions of this part of Rajasthan.

Sunset Heritage Walk

HERITAGE & CULTURE

Vintage Car Museum — Fateh Vilas

Rs. 250 per person · + 18% GST

The Fateh Collection's private museum at Fateh Vilas houses one of the most distinguished collections of vintage and classic vehicles in Rajasthan. Assembled over generations, the collection reflects the family's long engagement with the history of the automobile — from rare pre-independence motorcars that graced the courts of maharajas, to military vehicles, two-wheelers, and heritage animal-drawn carriages, each carrying its own provenance and story.

The museum is as much a portrait of an era as it is a vehicle collection — a material record of the world that shaped Mewar in the twentieth century.

Arts & Crafts Experiences

Koftgiri — Metal Inlay Art

A craft that travelled from the courts of Persia to the armouries of Rajputana, Koftgiri once adorned the weapons of Rajput warriors and Mughal kings. Iron or steel surfaces are engraved by hand before fine gold or silver wire is embedded into the incisions, then heated and polished to reveal patterns of striking intricacy. Strength and elegance held in the same object.

Miniature Painting

The Mewar school of miniature painting is among the most celebrated in the subcontinent — vivid in colour, exacting in detail, and remarkable in its capacity to compress entire narratives into small formats. Artists work with handmade brushes of the finest animal hair and pigments derived from stones, minerals, and precious metals. Guests are introduced to the practice and invited to attempt their own work under guidance.

Block Printing

Among Rajasthan's oldest textile traditions, block printing in the Udaipur region is characterised by handcrafted wooden blocks, natural dyes, and a patient, deliberate process that cannot be hurried. The Dabu mud-resist technique and deep indigo dyeing are particular to this region — producing pieces whose character is inseparable from the hands and time invested in them.

Lac Bangle Making

Practised for generations by hereditary artisan communities, lac bangle making is one of Rajasthan's most tactile and alive craft traditions. Lacquer is heated over an open flame, shaped by hand, and set with colours, mirrors, and stones in a process that rewards instinct as much as skill. Once the preserve of royal households, these bangles remain among the region's most resonant objects.

Molela Terracotta

From the village of Molela near Udaipur, this tradition of hand-sculpted terracotta plaques has been practised without interruption for over 800 years. Artisans work entirely by hand — building up figures of local deities, folk narratives, and village scenes in clay before firing and painting each piece. A rare and largely undiscovered art form of profound cultural continuity.

Heritage Nail Painting

Derived from the Mewar School of Miniature Art, heritage nail painting applies the same principles of fine brushwork and exacting detail to an unconventional surface. Artisans use ultra-fine brushes to render scenes of royalty, wildlife, and nature on a scale that demands both precision and stillness. A craft that consistently surprises those who witness it.
