

JUNGLE SAFARI AT

Bandipur

The jungle safari at Bandipur are primarily organized, governed & controlled by the Forest Department and are subjected to change from time to time. We at The Serai shall not be held responsible for any last-minute safari cancellations by the Forest Department.

The jungle safari will be on a shared basis on an 18-seater canter van. The travel time from the resort to the Jungle safari

point is a 45-minute drive.

Below is the cost for the Jungle Safari on an 18-Seater Canter van:

FOR INDIAN NATIONALS

Rs.1800 + 18% GST

Children between 5 - 9 years of age:

Adult & Children above 9 years:

No charges for children between: 3 - 5 years of age

Rs.1600 + 18% GST

Children below 3 years of age are not allowed as per the Government rules.

Adult & Children above 9 years:

Rs.2500 + 18% GST

FOR FOREIGN NATIONALS

Children between 5 - 9 years of age: Rs.2200 + 18% GST

If you are unable to book the safari on the Government website, our team at the resort will assist you with the safari

booking on an 18-seater canter van during

your stay at the resort based on the

availability. The transport charges from the

resort to the safari point is included in the

total cost if it is booked by the resort.

Whereas, if the guest directly books the jungle safari on the Government website, they can either go in their own transport or the resort can arrange for the transport at an additional cost.

Photography is not allowed during the jungle safari. If you are a professional or an individual who is interested in

photography, you will have to take due permission from the Forest Department in

order to take the cameral equipment into

the jungle.

The charges for a camera are as follows:

Above 200mm - Rs.885

Below 200mm - Rs.177
