Vedic Village does the opposite — it lets nature beautify the resort.


Key environmental initiatives include:

- *Lakes reflecting sunrise and sunset across the property*

Architectural Sustainability

Earth, Craft & Climate

The resort's architecture follows ancient Indian wisdom — building with the earth, not on it.

Sustainable design features include:

Farm to Table in its Truest Form

Source fresh. Source regional. Source responsibly.*

Key practices include:

- *A significant percentage of produce grown in the resort's own kitchen farms*
- *Weekly haat-style procurement from nearby villages supporting micro farmers*
- *Celebration of traditional grains and ingredients, including:*
 - *Gobindobhog rice*
 - *Millets*
 - *Red rice*
 - *Indigenous leafy greens*
- *Seasonal menu rotation, reducing cold storage dependency and food miles*
- *Revival of traditional cooking techniques, including:*
 - *Kulhad chai*
 - *Terracotta cooking vessels*
 - *Slow fire cooking and slow stews*

Dining becomes more than indulgence — it becomes an education in sustainable gastronomy.



The Green Supply Chain

The resort has redesigned procurement systems around community partnerships and responsible sourcing.

Key practices include:

- *Direct collaborations with local weavers, potters, farmers, and small producers*
- *Preference for biodegradable disposables, natural linens, and low-chemical housekeeping supplies*
- *Direct farmer contracts ensuring fair pricing and transparent supply chains*
- *Vendor policies encouraging:*
 - *Low packaging waste*
 - *Ethical labour practices*

Here, love leaves memories — not carbon footprints.






A Philosophy, Not a Program
