










Naini Lake

Approx. 1.5 km from Shervani Hilltop



The Beating Heart of Nainital

Set like a shimmering emerald in the heart of the town, Naini Lake is one of the most iconic and beloved attractions in Nainital — and rightly so. Flanked by lush hills on all sides and steeped in legends, this crescent-shaped natural lake is a sight to behold at any hour of the day.

Hop onto a rowboat or paddle boat and let the gentle ripples guide you through serenity. As you glide across the water, take in the sights of colonial-era buildings on one side and dense forested slopes on the other. Morning rides offer a peaceful, misty charm, while evening cruises turn magical as the lake reflects the golden glow of town lights and the dusky sky.

Locals believe the lake to be sacred — it is said to be one of the 64 Shakti Peethas, associated with the mythology of Goddess Sati. The Naina Devi Temple, perched at the lake's northern end, adds a divine aura to this tranquil setting.


Whether you're seeking romance, stillness, spirituality, or simply a postcard-perfect photograph, Naini Lake will leave you mesmerized — again and again.

Naina Devi Temple

A serene hilltop shrine overlooking Naini Lake, Naina Devi Temple is one of Nainital's most sacred sites. Dedicated to Goddess Naina Devi, it's believed to be where her eyes fell — giving the town its name.


With peaceful surroundings and divine energy, it's perfect for quiet prayer or reflection. Especially vibrant during Navratri and Nanda Ashtami, the temple draws visitors seeking blessings and calm.

Kainchi Dham

A Spiritual Oasis in the Mountains

Tucked amidst the lush Kumaon hills on the Nainital-Almora road lies Kainchi Dham — a sacred ashram and temple complex that exudes serenity and spiritual energy. Established in the 1960s by the legendary Hindu mystic Neem Karoli Baba, this site has since become a beacon for spiritual seekers from across India and the globe.

Set alongside a babbling stream and embraced by dense forests, the ashram offers an atmosphere of deep peace and introspection. The temple is beautifully maintained and radiates a profound stillness that invites prayer, meditation, and inner reflection.

Kainchi Dham holds a special place in the hearts of its visitors — from humble devotees to global personalities like Steve Jobs, Mark Zuckerberg, and countless spiritual pilgrims who have drawn strength and guidance from Neem Karoli Baba's teachings.


Visitors often describe a sense of calm and clarity upon entering the premises. Tuesdays are considered particularly auspicious, and the annual June bhandara (mass feeding ceremony) draws thousands of devotees in celebration.

Touch the Himalayas With Your Eyes

One of Nainital's most iconic viewpoints, Snow View Point offers spectacular vistas of the snow-covered Himalayan peaks — including Nanda Devi, Trishul, and Nanda Kot. Easily accessible by a scenic cable car ride from Mallital or a short trek through forested paths, it's a perfect spot for sunrise views and panoramic photography.

Cool mountain breezes, clear blue skies, and the majestic snow line make this a must-visit during your stay.




The Highest Point of Nainital

Towering at 2,615 meters, Naina Peak (also known as China Peak) is the highest point in Nainital, offering breathtaking 360° views of the Himalayan range and the lake-dotted valley below.

Reach the summit through a scenic forest trek filled with chirping birds and shaded trails, or enjoy a peaceful pony ride from Mallital. The reward at the top? A sense of serenity, crisp mountain air, and sweeping views that stretch far beyond the town.

It's an ideal spot for solitude, nature photography, and experiencing the untouched beauty of the Kumaon hills.


₱ Best visited early morning or just before sunset for golden light and clear skies.



Tiffin Top (Dorothy's Seat)

A Poet's Picnic Point

Nestled atop Ayarpatta Hill, Tiffin Top — also known as Dorothy's Seat — is a scenic viewpoint built in memory of English artist Dorothy Kellet. The 4 km uphill trail winds through quiet forest paths and opens up to a charming terraced perch overlooking the valleys of Nainital.

It's a favourite among nature lovers, artists, and anyone seeking a peaceful escape from the bustle of town. Carry a book, a picnic basket, or simply your thoughts — and spend a few quiet hours with the breeze, birdsong, and breathtaking views.


Perfect for morning treks, light meals under the sky, or sunset moments you'll want to hold onto.

Hanuman Garhi

Visitors flock here to witness breathtaking sunsets, where the sky paints vibrant hues behind the majestic mountains — a truly soul-stirring experience. The temple's peaceful atmosphere invites prayer, meditation, and moments of reflection.


A short uphill walk or drive brings you to this cherished local gem, offering panoramic views of the town below and the rolling hills beyond.





† Approx. 13 km from Shervani Hilltop (via Kilbury Road)





Ideal for day trips, nature lovers, and photographers alike, these lakes offer tranquil escapes and unforgettable moments.

Sattal Lake

Approx. 25 km from Shervani Hilltop

A cluster of seven interconnected freshwater lakes surrounded by thick oak and pine forests. Sattal is a birdwatcher's paradise and a serene spot for kayaking nature walks, and quiet reflection.



Bhimtal Lake

📍 Approx. 23 km from Shervani Hilltop

Larger and quieter than Naini Lake, Bhimtal is known for its island aquarium and scenic boating experiences. Fringed with cafes and a peaceful promenade, it's perfect for a lakeside lunch.



Naukuchiatal Lake

Approx. 26 km from Shervani Hilltop

The "Lake of Nine Corners" — this mystical, deep blue lake is famed for its symmetrical beauty and water sports. Legends say one glimpse of all nine corners brings fortune.



Khurpatal Lake

📍 Approx. 10 km from Shervani Hilltop


A hidden gem nestled among pine-covered slopes. Khurpatal is known for its emerald waters and peaceful vibe. A favorite of anglers and solitude seekers.

Astronomical Observatory

Approx. 12 km from Shervani Hilltop



Touch the Stars

Operated by the prestigious ARIES (Aryabhatta Research Institute of Observational Sciences), this observatory is a unique gateway to the cosmos. Located just a short drive from the hotel, it offers guided night sky viewing sessions on select moonlit days.

Explore the wonders of the universe as expert astronomers introduce you to dazzling constellations, distant galaxies, and the mysteries of stars through powerful telescopes. This is a rare opportunity to connect with the universe in a serene mountain setting.
